#### **True or False**

1. \_\_\_\_\_ In addition to the music from the WSMA Festival Music List, Event 811-Piano trios may submit literature for “permission allowed” approval.
2. \_\_\_\_\_ In multi-movement selections, unless otherwise specified, students must perform two contrasting movements or the performance will receive a Critique Only.
3. \_\_\_\_\_ “Critique Only” entries perform for comments, but are not rated.
4. \_\_\_\_\_ In solo-ensemble events, the adjudicator must be provided with an original, publisher printed copy of the matching edition of music being performed or the performance will receive a Critique Only.
5. \_\_\_\_\_ Memorization is mandatory in all solo class A piano events.
6. \_\_\_\_\_ Constructive and reinforcing written comments on the back of the rubric form are highly encouraged.
7. \_\_\_\_\_ In Piano Solo and Duet Events, music must be selected from the current WSMA Festival Music List, unless it is an original student composition with a “WSMA Permission Granted” form attached.
8. \_\_\_\_\_ Soloists who qualify for the State Festival must perform the same solo they performed at the District Festival.
9. \_\_\_\_\_ Permission to perform a selection not on the music list will be indicated by a “WSMA Permission Granted” form attached to the adjudicator’s music.
10. \_\_\_\_\_ Student soloists are expected to introduce their solo performance to the adjudicator and audience at both District and State Festivals. The introduction, however, is not part of the rating.
